


Campbell's Place Commitment to the Community

Serving The Public Safely: Our Practices

Our staff has exceeded in compliance and has practiced best hygiene: masks, gloves, hand washing and social distancing. In order to dramatically minimize contact between staff and guests, we are currently only accepting credit cards. We will collect payment at the time of your order and your receipt will be stapled to your take out bag. Upon arrival detailed instructions are posted about the pick-up process, complimentary gloves and clearly marked waiting areas.

Meals Provided by Campbell's Place with the Help of Our Generous Donors

- ~50 Meals for ER nightshift at Einstein Medical in East Norriton
